Recommended reading materials can be read in any particular order and can be read over and over again. Be flexible as to the time of day that best suits your schedule (wake-up time, before bedtime, before lunch, after lunch, during quiet time, after naps, in your car driving to appointments or activities, etc). It is completely up to you. Read-alouds and audiobooks are great ways to expose young children to the vast world of literature— all the treasures within while giving them the key with which to unlock this world independently one day.
